Literacy: Alongside teaching our successful phonics scheme RWInc, children will be encouraged to read and write for pleasure. They will use our school and class library and enjoy hearing lots of stories. They will be telling, reading and writing stories and bringing books home for you to share. In class they will be blending sounds together for reading and segmenting words into sounds for spelling. They will look at sentence structure and begin to write independently. Children will continue to improve their letter formation. We will be focussing on traditional tales and hope to see lots of original tales that the children have written.

Numeracy: Children will have the opportunity to experience all aspects of numeracy six times a week. This term's focus is to be confident with reading and writing number to 30. They will recognise these numbers and will begin to order them. They will be learning about addition through combining sets and counting on a number line. They will count back along a number line when subtracting and take away objects from sets. Children will recognise, name and describe some 2D and 3D shapes.
