Literacy: We will encourage the children to develop their love of books by reading a variety of stories. They will be reading and writing stories with familiar settings and learning to re-tell some of their favourites. In their Phonics lessons they will continue learning sounds for reading and which letters represent these sounds when spelling. They will be improving their letter formation and learning about nouns, verbs and adjectives.



Numeracy: Children will be adding, subtracting and multiplying numbers with the use of number lines and begin to learn their times tables. They will learn about the importance of Place Value and use this to order numbers. They will look at patterns of numbers on a Hundred Square and recognise odd and even numbers. Practical equipment will be used to explore numbers and calculations.
