Literacy: In Literacy, children are continuing their Literacy and Language. Through drama and discussion the children will learn how to read and perform a play and use this to write their own play script. They will also focus on stories from other cultures. They will also be exploring non-fictional texts which will result in writing an explanation text.

Numeracy: Children will continue to develop their number work using all 4 operations through problem solving to apply what they have learned. They will continue to investigate 2D and 3D shapes. Children will be learning how to add and subtract using decimals. They will also analyse data using a range of graphs and charts to record information. They will also apply knowledge learned to investigate sequences, patterns and explain their rules.
