## Curriculum information for parents

### Summer Term 2017

#### ***Trips:***

*A trip to the Wrekin.*

*A 'Picnic in the Park'*

**Literacy:** Children will focus on writing story and explanation texts using descriptive techniques. In addition to this, they will work on their spelling, grammar and punctuation skills which they will apply when writing both formally and informally. The children will read a variety of classical texts both in class and within literacy lessons, practising their inference and deduction skills.



**Numeracy:** Children will continue to practise their 4 Rules of Number with a greater emphasis on applying through practical sessions. The children will develop their understanding of data handling, ratio and proportion.

#### ***Science:***

Children will learn about electricity recognising basic symbols and constructing simple circuits from a diagram that they have produced. In addition, they will recognise how diet impacts on their health and well-being.



#### ***History: Railways***

To understand the importance of the railways and the influence they had on everyday life. To be made aware of the dangers associated to playing by railway lines.

**Geography:** While studying railways we will look at different locations around Britain and the influence of railways across the British Empire.

**Design and Technology:** The children will plan and build a bridge and test the strength to evaluate their design.



**Art:** Will be closely linked to our History topic where the children will have the opportunity to work with a variety of materials to create, make and evaluate their own art work.

**ICT:** Children will learn to use software that will enable them to produce and edit their own movies to present their topic research.

#### ***Religious Education:***

The belief in the afterlife will be discussed and compared between different religions.

**Music:** This term the children will learn and rehearse the song and dance routines for the end of term production.

**PSHE:** Learning about 'Risk' and how to keep themselves safe in the modern world.

**Physical Education:** The children will be participating in athletics, fitness routines and ball games including handball.
