#### *Literacy:*

Alongside teaching our successful phonics scheme Read Write Inc. children will be encouraged to read and write for pleasure. They will use our Busy Books library and enjoy hearing lots of stories. They will be telling, reading and writing stories and bringing books home for you to share. In class they will be blending sounds together for reading and segmenting words into sounds for spelling. They will look at sentence structure and begin to write independently. Children will continue to improve their letter formation, alongside learning and appreciating poems and rhymes. They will be researching a variety of different traditional rhymes and identifying the rhyming words.

#### *Numeracy:*

Children will have the opportunity to experience all aspects of numeracy. This term's focus is to become confident counting forwards and backwards along a number line. They will be recognising numbers up to 30 and beyond and will begin to order them. They will be learning about addition through combining sets and counting on a number line. They will count back along a number line when subtracting and take away objects from sets. Children will recognise, name and describe some 2D and 3D shapes.

*Plan an animated story.*

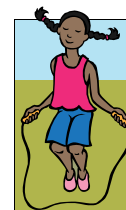
*Learn how to use the internet safely to communicate.*
