Literacy :

Children will be reading a range of books. They will explore topics through non-fiction and read poetry and stories with familiar settings. They will experience acting out scenes from stories and be encouraged to learn poems. Participation in speaking and listening tasks is a focus for this term. They will be encouraged to share and discuss their opinions. They will continue to build on their phonic knowledge for spelling and improve their understanding of sentence construction and grammar. Please help them with any spellings they have to learn.

Numeracy:

Understanding place value is a focus for this term. Reading and writing 2 and 3 digit numbers, ordering them and partitioning them in different ways. They will learn to apply their knowledge to answer problems using addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. They will also learn to measure length and weight and total coins. You could help your child to tell the time.

Science: Living things and their habitats:

Children will be learning about animal habitats, specifically habitats found in rainforests and chocolate growing countries.



History: The history of chocolate from Aztecs to the present day.

Famous People: The Cadbury Family, Montezuma and the Spanish Conquistadors.

Geography: Comparing a Non-European country to Dudley. Using maps and atlases to locate important features. Contrasting the climate of a cocoa growing country to the UK.

Design and Technology: Designing chocolate products.
