Literacy: Children will be reading a range of stories from notable and significant authors. The non-fiction focuses will be newspaper recounts and biographies. They will also begin to study different forms of poetry.

Numeracy: Children will be multiplying and dividing whole numbers and decimal numbers. They will learn about fractions, decimals and percentages and learn to manipulate them.

Science: Solids, Liquids and Gases, the water cycle and forces.

History - The Victorians: The children will continue their project on the Victorians

Geography: The children will learn about Europe and the European Union (EU).

Art: The children will study art by famous Victorian artists (notably William Morris) and produce their own work in the same style.



Religious Education:

1st half: Sikhism – Beliefs and moral values
2nd half: Christianity - Easter

ICT: E-mails, internet safety and presenting other work from across the curriculum.



Music: Children will study the pitch, pulse and rhythm of music and create their own using graphic notation.

PHSE: The children will focus on values- especially those of our New Year's resolution- respect and responsibility. The children will look at their place in the wider world and how global issues can affect them.

Physical Education: Indoor athletics and cross-country.
